

INFANT ROBINSON

This was the second child of David Shannon and Nancy Carolina (Fountain) Robinson. The baby was born on March 22, 1857 in Cat Creek, near Valdosta, Berrien County, Georgia and died on March 31, 1857 at nine days old. It is unknown whether the baby was a male or female. It is believed that the baby is buried at Pleasant Cemetery, which is near Pleasant Primitive Baptist Church. This church is now referred to as "Old Pleasant" Church and was constituted in June 1835 (See Exhibit 5-5 for photograph of church).

It is believed the infant was buried here for several reasons. David Shannon and Nancy Carolina were of the Primitive Baptist faith and it was the nearest cemetery to their homestead at Cat Creek. Also, Nancy's brother, William E. Fountain, and his wife, Frances, were active members of the church.

This information about the baby's birth and death was recorded in David Shannon Robinson's family bible, which Joseph Leonard Robinson has in his possession (See Exhibit 3-3C for family bible records [in previous chapter]).

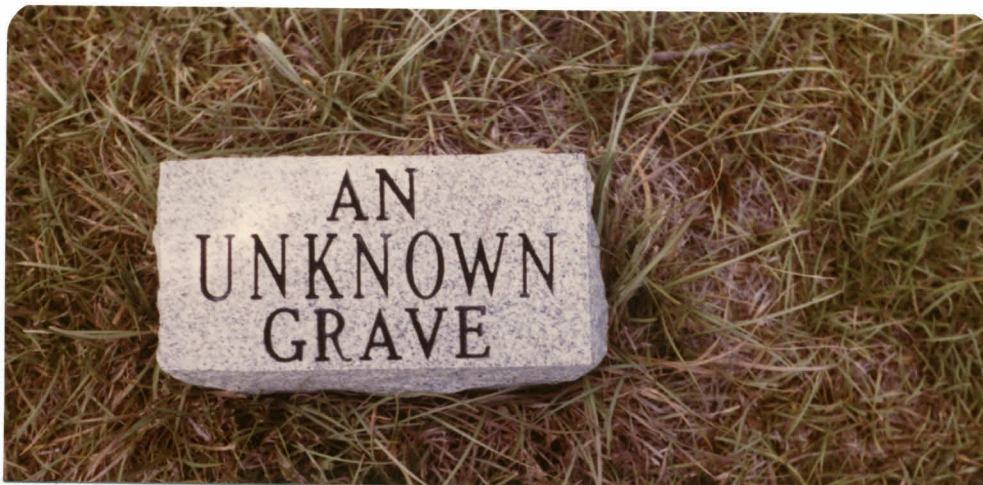
